VENUE for MEETINGS: Copthorne Hotel and Resort Solway park.

SUNDAY 10 APRIL 2011 - MEETING DAY.

For the business sessions pre- AGM, and council meetings, followed by welcome and Opening Dinner.

MONDAY 11 APRIL - MEETING DAY.

For special interest groups and the AGM. For those not involved there will be an optional interesting day tour to Historic homestead *Brancepeth*, Gladstone for lunch and then a visit to *Stonehenge*.

The Awards Dinner in the evening is a must.

TUESDAY 12 APRIL - EASTERN FIELD DAY

Traverse of iconic Castlepoint Station, a windswept coastal property where isolated pockets of forestry were harvested in 2007 before risk of a penalty. Riparian planting in natives and a neighbouring property recently purchased with 130 hectares of 13 year pines for carbon credits to help subsidise the land purchase are among topics that will be discussed.

Afternoon visit to **Rewanui Forest Park,** a Montfort Trimble Foundation property, to visit large area of native bush retired, 20 different indigenous and 12 exotic species trials and learn from the work and measurements completed to date.

WED. 13 APRIL - CENTRAL FIELD DAY.

An early start for the first 100 enrolled, to Mt. Bruce, Pukaha to hear the *dawn chorus* followed by breakfast at Pukaha, being joined by the late risers. The Kokaka is of considerable interest. On the return to Masterton we will pass the Mt. Bruce plantations of the Montfort Trimble Foundation.

Lunch at Henley Lake, a manmade lake adjacent to Masterton where the local Farm Forestry group have taken on a number of plantings.

In the afternoon we visit the ground durable Eucalyptus trial and the Makoura restoration scheme, followed by a mass planting on the stream edge. Alternative dinner – 2012 presentation, and auction.

THURS 14 APRIL – SOUTHERN FIELD DAY.

First visit of the day is the *Wairio* Wetlands, (bring your gumboots) where a lot of good work is being done by various interested groups. Followed by a drive through *Pirinoa Station* view various plantings, a massive feedlot, and if it is dry a view through to the South Island. Lunch at Pirinoa Hall, then on to the *Barrage Gates* which are part of the Lake Wairarapa scheme. *Waiorongomai Station* follows an early Wairarapa Station celebrating 160 years one family ownership this year. Speckle cattle, stud sheep, wine tasting and casual meal at Anzac Hall, Featherston follows.
