Bay of Many Coves/Farnham Forest – forest

clearing/residential development.

Motuara Island – off shore island biodiversity management. Arapawa Island – whaling, pine harvesting.

Disembark at Ship Cove - history of James Cook's visits to the area and Joseph Banks accounts of the bio diversity.

Sunday 13th April Marlborough Sounds – Pelorus

Please note Pelorus field trip is FULL Points of interest along the route to Hopai Farm are: Kaituna sawmill - Maher's forest & forestry Kaituna Valley. Havelock - Sandford's mussel factory. Mahakipawa Arm - Tai Tane Forest. Kaiuma Bay - Yealand's forest and subdivision. Mahau Sound – Skiddaw; recent logging. Nikau and Four Fathom Bay – forestry. Maori Bay - pine harvesting & early durable eucalypt planting. (Please note: Pelorus field trip is FULL)



Northwest Bay /South East Bay - pine forests, harvesting operation in NW Bay.

Old Homewood Bay, Pohuenui, Clova Bay & Crail Bays. <u>Disembark</u> at Hopai Bay – Farming operation & forestry plantings, bio diversity protection and restoration.
