

NEW ZEALAND FARM FORESTRY ASSOCIATION (Inc.) 60th ANNUAL NATIONAL CONFERENCE Hokitika Sunday 17th April - Thursday 21st April 2016 (plus optional Friday 22nd special Tour)

"The West Coast - Something For Everyone"

Members of The West Coast Farm Forestry Association welcome you to the West Coast for the 60th Annual National Conference. The Conference will be based at Hokitika's Regent Theatre with interesting fieldtrips around our region. Local farm foresters will ensure that you will have a memorable and enjoyable Conference. The West Coast is truly a special place to visit!

Conference Programme Sunday 17th April

This is "Arrival Day" and registration opens in the afternoon. There will be an opportunity for visitors to visit the West Coast Industrial Heritage Park and then Lake Kaniere to view tall native forest and windthrow storm effects.

Around 4.30pm we will gather in the theatre for some local talks and our "Trees on Farms" videos. Followed by a drinks and nibbles function from 6.00pm to 7.00pm that will enable delegates to meet and greet. Then a free evening for local town dining (bookings recommended).

Monday 18th April

In the morning Branch and Council Meetings will be held with an optional scenic visit (limited seats, bring your Dimp) to Hokitika Gorge which should have you back for the AGM.

After morning tea the AGM will be held at 10.45am in the Regent Theatre.

Lunch is self-catering. There is a wide range of cafés and bakeries in our town.

Trees on Farms videos will be screened during the week in the Regent. In the afternoon there is the field trip to two Stafford Loop forest properties. In the evening there will be pre-dinner drinks and the Opening Dinner at the Boys' Brigade Hall.

Tuesday 19th April

The Formal Conference Opening will take place at 8.00am followed by forest industry speakers. Action Groups will commence at 11.30 and at 12.30 (Bring your own lunch as we are trialling working lunch sessions.) At 3.00pm we leave for the afternoon and evening

which will be spent at Shantytown where there will be time to explore the historic pioneer village before the formal Conference Awards Dinner. Maybe take a free steam train ride or try gold panning (\$7 guarantees 'a colour'). There are excellent sawmilling, foundry and steam engine displays.

Wednesday 20th April

Conference Guest Speaker at 8.00am. Morning field trip to Jack Davidson's sheep and tree property at Arahura.

Lunch is again self-catering.

At 1.30pm the afternoon field trip leaves for Mahinapua Forest which will include entry to, and afternoon tea at, the Treetop Walkway. An Evening light barbeque tea and drinks, again at the Boys' Brigade Hall, concludes the day leaving time for socialising in town.

Thursday 21st April

This is the "Big Day" – an all Day Field Trip, departing at 8.15am, to the Grey Valley including: Noel Hardie's Maori Gully property, A Landcorp dairy unit, Granville Nursery site and special purpose trees, Lunch provided at Totara Flat in a local hall, Ken Ferguson's property Waipuna Station, Reefton NZSFP Veneer Plant. Conference concludes with Dinner in Reefton after which the buses will return you to Hokitika.

Friday 22nd April – Optional extra

Post Conference Tour to South Westland This is intended as a relaxed visit (includes lunch) to visit the quality Blackwood stands at Lake Ianthe Forest. It is intended to stop at a sawmill demonstration at Ross. Additionally there will be discussions of special purpose species including the SCION trials. And a visit to a nearby indigenous Rimu forest if time permits.
